The Impinda, meaning “folding, repeating” in Zulu, is a slip joint, and while it's non-locking, it's not your average jack-knife. The blade design, an homage to Harsey’s custom made Tactical Trout knives, is proven in the outdoors and made with Reeve precision. Innovations to the spring allow for ease of opening and safety of closing.

Fifty Impinda knives will release at the 2018 Blade Show. We will release 50 plain titanium with a CPM S35VN blade and spring, along with a limited run (10) with Unique Graphics and a Damasteel drop point blade & spring.

As a slip joint and non-locking knife, the most important part of the Impinda is the relationship between the blade and spring. The Impinda manages pressure at every point of contact, from open through close using a differential spring pressure. The results are a smoother opening, safer closing, and positive engagement in the fully- open position.
